PURPOSE: To empower students to strengthen their coding abilities. Students are first challenged to think about the means through which they can accomplish a task and then watch their challenge come to completion through the use of Cue, the coding robot.

IMPACT: The project assisted students in reproducing unseen "creation" through communication. Students discussed the roles of the Entrepreneur, the Manager, and the Builder and how each plays a role in the workplace. The Innovation and Creativity unit challenged students to think imaginatively about an idea or problem and then turn it into an entrepreneurial opportunity. Legos were utilized to create a "product" that required students to work together in the roles of the Entrepreneur, the Manager, and the Builder.

FUTURE PLANS: The project will continue and will be utilized across many Business classes. The Cue robots will be used in future IDEA classes for freshman.
