<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this grant was to expand the technology available for classroom use as the school moved to personalized learning. With the addition of 30 Chromebooks purchased with the grant, one third of the classroom population in grades 2-8 were provided with the technology to meet the needs of students for personalized learning

IMPACT: The grant allowed the students to have greater access to technology in the classroom on a daily basis. With the outbreak of the coronavirus bringing in-classroom instruction to a halt, the additional Chromebooks allowed the school to lend more out to students for use in distance learning, particularly to those who do not have access (or have limited access) to technology at home. Using the Chromebooks regularly in the classroom earlier in the school year better prepared students for distance learning.

FUTURE PLANS: The Chromebooks will continue to be used for personalized learning in the future.
