PURPOSE: To strengthen preschool students' fine motor strength. Strong fine motor muscles in their hands lead to good cutting, gluing, coloring, writing and drawing.

IMPACT: The grant allowed preschool students to strengthen their little hand muscles while having fun and meeting curriculum objectives. The students also learned the correct way to cut and hold a writing instrument whether it be a crayon, marker or pencil. Creating a strong base in the early years makes the child more confident for the upcoming year. The kindergarten teacher will be so pleased that most of incoming students know how to cut correctly, can write their names neatly, and have a solid pencil grasp. This will ease their transition to more seat work next year.

FUTURE PLANS: The project will be implemented again next year.
