PURPOSE: To display artwork around the school and in the community in the form of Pop Up Art Shows. With the purchase of portable display towers, shelves, and screens, art exhibits were showcased in libraries, schools, community centers, churches, hospitals and restaurants. The purchase of document cameras allowed live demonstrations that could be projected on a screen. The goal was twofold: expand the ability to exhibit year round and to "take it on the road" to promote the Fine Arts department.

IMPACT: The grant had a very positive impact on student performance. The technology helped to enhance communication which led to better outcomes. The Pop Up Art Exhibits gave students confidence in their ability to make, create, display, take down, and receive real time feedback. The community had an opportunity to see what we do at Immaculate High School and to view a live art show. As a marketing tool, we had many inquiries by prospective freshmen who are interested in the Fine Arts at Immaculate.

FUTURE PLANS: The purchases will be used for many years. We plan to fundraise by selling artwork and offering both in-person and virtual drawing and painting classes.
