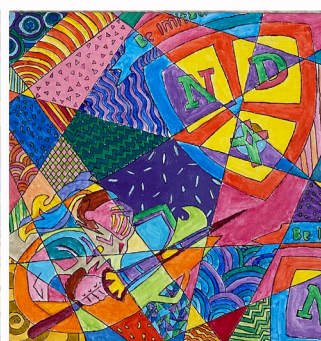
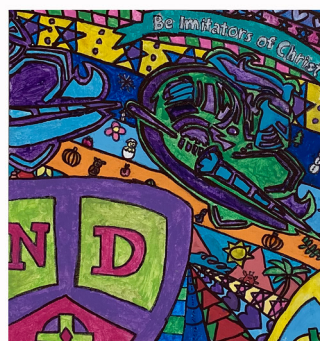


30 Students Impacted
