PURPOSE: The video recording studio was initially intended to reside in the Innovation Lab however due to the pandemic, the materials purchased such as camera, tripods, and microphone were integrated into the classrooms and used to enhance and improve Distance Learning programs. Students used the technology to demonstrate mastery in core subjects while developing digital and media literacy.

IMPACT: The grant enable HTCA to have better qualitative instruction to those who had to participate in Distance Learning as a result of quarantine or choice. Distance Learners were able to keep up with their studies and "socialize" with their classmates with the help of this grant.
