**PURPOSE:** To use a document camera to give students the ability to see text clearly from anywhere, whether they are learning in the classroom or from home. A document camera enables students to follow along as the teacher walks through worksheets and activities and gives teachers the flexibility to manipulate the materials and help them come “alive” for the student.

**IMPACT:** Every student had a clear view of the task at hand, allowing younger students to be more independent. They had more confidence finding pages in books, completing activities and helping friends with assignments. The best part is seeing the excitement when students come up and “teach” their classmate using the document camera. They are more willing to try new tasks when we are using the document camera because they are able to demonstrate what they are explaining to the class, especially in math where they can move the manipulatives.

**FUTURE PLANS:** We will continue to utilize document cameras in the classrooms.
