PURPOSE: To create a World Language experience that allowed our fifth grade students to be introduced to Latin, Italian and Spanish. Additionally, with this program, sixth through eighth grade students chose one of these languages and studied it for a year. The Rosetta Stone program is web-based so that it also allowed students to hone their technology skills.

IMPACT: The quality of World Language lessons greatly improved using Rosetta Stone. Students gain a rudimentary foundation in a variety of languages which allows them to be more informed when choosing a language for high school. Some students were able to demonstrate mastery and competency which may help them to advance in high school. Students were able to work at their own pace and thus, have greater success.

FUTURE PLANS: This program will continue in the future. Tuition has been adjusted to cover the costs.
